REGULATIONS

The City of Onaway is a snowmobile-friendly community. We invite snowmobilers to come into town and visit our businesses. All of that said, City Ordinance 2008-05 does set some rules, and they are as follows:

Snowmobiles are permitted on the far right-hand portion of all side streets and developed alleys, and on sidewalks along all state highways within the city limits of Onaway, with the exception of the sidewalks along M-68, between Second and Maple, and along M-211 between Cedar and M-68.

- Operation must be in single file, with the flow of traffic, at a speed not greater than 25 miles per hour.
- Operators must stop at all intersections, including those not posted with stop signs.
- Operators must hand signal all turns and stops.
- Operators cannot pass vehicles moving in the same direction as the snowmobile.
- Operators cannot tow passengers with the snowmobile unless doing so using a commercially manufactured trailer designed for such affixed properly to the snowmobile.
- Snowmobiles are not allowed to travel through private yards without the permission of the property owner.
- Unnecessary, indiscriminate operation of a snowmobile up and down, or crossing, alleys, streets, or sidewalks is prohibited.
- Violation of the ordinance is a civil infraction, punishable by a fine of \$500.
